FREE Microsoft Surface Tablets

They have been completely wiped so that all school information has been removed.

Details:

Windows 10 - will need windows updates which may require restarts

Wireless – These Surface devices ONLY use WPA2
WPA2 is an older Security for wireless (Now they use WPA3)
When hotspotting to a new iPhone, select "Compatibility" for WPA2
At home NEW routers may NOT have WPA2 enabled by default

Microsoft Office - is not on the tablets but Office is available for ALL students on home devices. Instructions for how to access this will come with the device.

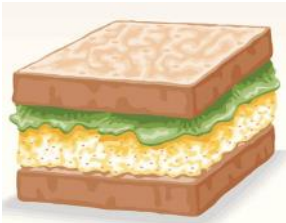
Just a reminder that we have a limited supply of groceries for anyone in our school community who are struggling financially.

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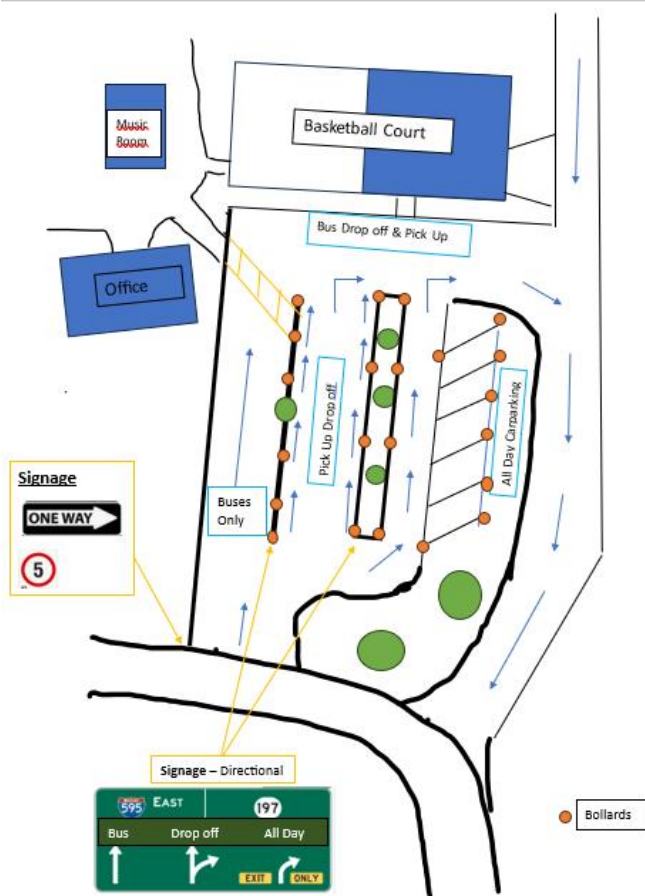


Art Cubes...
